Writing Competition Details are as follows:

- Three age groups: Under 12, 12 to 17 and Adult
- Topic: Celebrating Libraries & Books and What They Mean To Me
- Any genre accepted! Poetry, fiction, non-fiction, memoir, biography, your personal story - You choose what to write!

Writing Competition Rules:

No more than two pages.

Type written entries preferred. If typed, use a 12 font or larger and double-spaced lines. If hand-written, it must be VERY neat and must be legible.

On a cover page - stapled to but separate from your writing - please include the following:

- 1) Your Name
- 2) Your age group (Under 12, 12 to 17, or 18 and older)
- 3) Your telephone number
- 4) Your email address
- 5) The title of your story or poem

On the story itself, please **do not** include your name or contact information Just make sure to include your age group and the title of your story or poem.

All entries must be dropped off at the Miramar Library at the Adult Reference Desk so that all who participate actually have a tie to the Miramar Branch Library, since it is the Miramar Library Branch's anniversary that is being celebrated. (**No email submissions will be accepted!**)

The deadline is Saturday, Sept. 1, 2018. Winners will be announced at the Miramar Library's 10th Year Anniversary Party on Saturday, September 22, 2018 beginning at 1:00 pm (Writing Contest winners will be announced and some entries will be read aloud at 2:00 pm).

Prizes will be awarded for each age group and all those who submit entries may be invited to read their work at the Miramar Library's 10th Year Anniversary Celebration Party on Saturday, September 22, 2018! (You do not have to attend the Miramar Library's 10th Year Anniversary Celebration Party on Saturday, September 22, 2018 to participate in the contest. Even if you can't come or if you don't want to read your writing out loud, submit your story anyway - who knows, you might win a prize!)
